### VETERANS AND TROOP PAY

That is why Congressman Dreier voted to:

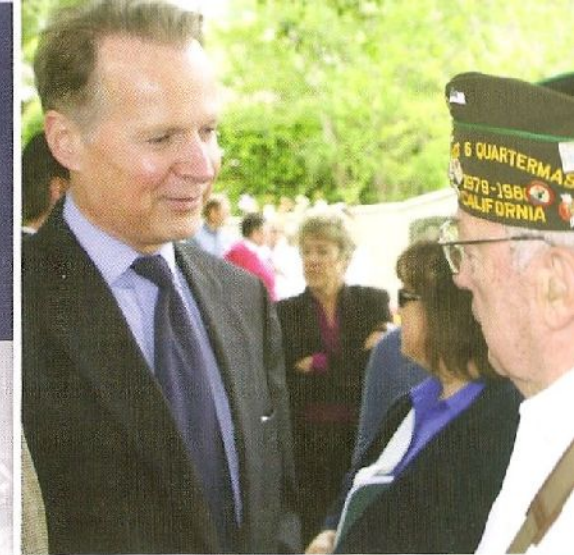
- ✓ Provide a 3.9 percent immediate pay raise for all members of the Armed Services.

### VETERANS EDUCATION

G.I. education benefits must be modernized and improved so veterans and their families can get a top quality education.

To accomplish this important goal, Congressman Dreier voted to:

- ✓ Expand education benefits under the Montgomery G.I. program to give veterans a top four-year college education.
- ✓ Provide veterans the ability to transfer unused education benefits to their spouse or children.
- ✓ Provide help with tutoring and housing costs.
- ✓ Match dollar for dollar financial aid veterans receive directly from colleges they are attending.
